

# **GRAPHIC AND PUBLISHING STANDARDS OF THE JOURNAL AMMENTU - *Bollettino Storico e Archivistico del Mediterraneo e delle Americhe***

- Entries shall be written in Times New Roman font, size 12, and 10 for footnotes, which shall be numbered consecutively. Paragraph titles shall be in bold type (for example: **1. Religion and power**).
- The text of the essay shall contain between 4,500 and 12,000 words, **i.e. a maximum of 80,000 characters**, including footnotes and spaces. No bibliography is required at the end of the essay.
- Italics shall be used sparingly, only being inserted to emphasize ideas of particular importance or to indicate foreign words which are not commonly used. However, **bold type** shall not be used at all in the body of the text.
- Photos and illustrations, if any, shall be accompanied by the **titles and sources** (and, where appropriate, by a footnote and a legend). Illustrations shall be in black and white **or colour**.

**NOTES.** Notes shall be numbered consecutively and inserted as footnotes.

## **System for including bibliographic references:**

### **1. Titles of works included in one or more volumes:**

When quoting the details of a work, the following order shall be followed: Full name and surname in normal characters followed by a comma, the full title of the work mentioned (in italics) followed by a comma, the city followed by a comma, the publisher followed by a comma, and the year of publication. Example: LAURO ROSSI, *Ideale nazionale e democrazia in Italia. Da Foscolo a Garibaldi*, Rome, Gangemi, 2013.

When the same author and work is quoted, the following abbreviated form shall be used: ROSSI, *Ideale nazionale*, cit., p. 80.

When the same author is quoted but from a different work, the following abbreviated form shall be used: Idem/Eadem, followed by the title in accordance with the instructions in point 1.

When the quote is from the same work as mentioned in a previous note but from a different page, the following form shall be used: Ivi, p. 90.

When the same author, work and page are quoted in the following note, *Ibid.* shall be indicated.

**2. Works under the direction of:**

When a work under the direction of a particular person is quoted, after the name of the person responsible, (under the direction of) shall be indicated in the case of works in Italian. Example: LORENZO BIANCHI (under the direction of), *Il potere temporale dei papi*, Rome, Donzelli, 1993.

**3. Article from a printed journal:**

When an article from a printed journal is quoted, the name of the publication shall be written in inverted commas “ ” and the year of edition, number, date (month and year) and pages shall be specified; the title, as in all other cases, shall be in italics. Example: ISRAEL SALVATOR RÉVAH, *Uriel da Costa e i marrani di Porto*, in “La “Rassegna Mensile d’Israel”, LXXV, nº 1-2, January-August 2009, pp. 191-208.

**4. Article from a digital journal:**

When an article from a digital journal is quoted, the name of the publication shall be written in inverted commas “ ” and the year of edition, number, date (month and year), pages, website of the journal and date of viewing of the article shall be specified; the title, as in all other cases, shall be in italics. Example: NUNZIATELLA ALESSANDRINI, *Giovanni Dall’Olmo, um veneziano em Lisboa: comércio e diplomacia (1541-1588)*, in “Ammentu – Bollettino Storico, Archivistico e Consolare del Mediterraneo”, III, nº. 3, January-December 2013, pp. 155-175, <<https://www.centrostudisea.it/ammentu>> (November 30, 2013)

**5. Essay included in a miscellaneous volume:**

In the case of an essay included in a miscellaneous volume, the title shall precede the name of the person in charge of the whole work and the other bibliographic data described in point 1 shall be included. Example: NICOLA MELIS, *Lo statuto giuridico degli ebrei nell’Impero Ottomano*, in MARTINO CONTU, NICOLA MELIS, GIOVANNINO PINNA (under the direction of), *Ebraismo e rapporti con le culture del Mediterraneo nei secoli XVIII-XX*, Florence, Giuntina, 2003, pp. 139-156.

## **6. Newspaper articles:**

If a newspaper article is mentioned, the name of the newspaper shall be written in inverted commas “ ”. Example: “Il Corriere della Sera”, “New York Times”, etc. ANTONIO ROSSI, *Nuova ripresa dell'emigrazione italiana all'estero*, in Il “Corriere della Sera”, May 245, 2012, p. 27.

## **7. Quotes from the dictionary or other similar repertoires**

## **9. Archival sources**

References to archival sources shall be included in full: ARCHIVE AND CITY (in small capitals), holding, unit and page numbering in normal characters. Titles of holdings, fascicles and documents shall be written in italics.

Examples:
