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Issue number ten of the *Ammentu* Magazine shows a dossier entitled *Tra Americhe e Africa: storie di percorsi di migrazioni* (Between America and Africa: Stories of Emigration Routes), directed by Marco Zurru. The dossier includes four works: the first one is about the French emigration to Uruguay in the nineteenth century; the second one is about the movement to Latin America from the small island of La Maddalena; the third one is about the current Italian presence in Tunisia and Zanzibar; and finally, a fourth work about the “brain drain” from Sardinia to the United States.

In the section *Recensioni* two recent editorial proposals are collected: a synthesis of the contents, written by Roberto Ibba, of the book by Martino Contu, *L'emigrazione italiana in Uruguay attraverso le fonti consolari (1857-1865)* (Aipsa, Cagliari 2017, pp. 156); and the critique, proposed by Simone Seu, of the book by Michela Murgia, *Terre promesse* (Nottetempo, Milan 2017, pp. 210).
